- Assess ship-ship or ship-shore compatibility in preparation liquefied gas transfer operations;
- Follow up on corporate forms by creating workflows and optimizing content;
- Follow up on regulation and reporting by coordinating new regulations (IMO, EU, Flag) and organising reporting for IMO DCS, EU MRV and Vessel General Permit;
- Maintain procedures and work instructions for all fleets on the above subjects and assist middle management in development and role out of various procedures;
- Work closely together with colleagues of different departments in order to ensure high HSEQ standards/requirements are integrated in the SMS and throughout the organisation and a regular review of the company management system is done;
- Research HSEQ and Marine related topics and participate in HSEQ related projects in order to provide guidance to the office and the fleet.

- Sailing experience as a Master or Chief Officer on gas carriers;
